“School Discipline & the ADHD Student”

Have you wondered what you can do if your child is suspended, other than leave them homebound? Has your child been suspended where ADHD was a factor in the discipline? The California Education Code proscribes the rules and student rights with respect to suspension and expulsion in public schools. Attorney Meldie Moore will explore the school discipline process, the common violations leading to discipline, and how students with ADHD may be entitled to extra protections before expulsion or extended suspensions may be imposed.
